Commonwealth Games Scotland visits the Gold Coast

With just 325 days until Games time, Team Scotland travelled to the Gold Coast to receive an update on GOLDOC planning from numerous functional areas, view the progress of the competition venues, meet with their respective GOLDOC Sport Competition Manager and view their sports' training facilities.

For some of the travellers, this was their first time to Australia and the Gold Coast.

During their time on the Gold Coast, some of the team also travelled up to Cairns and Townsville to view the regional city venues for preliminary rounds of Basketball.



Team Size Calculator (TSC) v2

TSC v2 was distributed to CGAs on Friday 5 May 2017. Each CGA also received a copy of their Sport Qualification Tracking document. Please reference the Sport Qualification Tracking document when completing TSC v2 and include the most accurate information possible.

As mentioned in the April newsletter, the accuracy of these numbers in the TSC is critical as this helps inform many GOLDOC planning areas such as Villages, Transport, Sport and Catering.

TSC v2 is due back to your CGA Relations Manager by 2 June 2017.

GFS10 (Identification on Personal, Competition Clothing and Personal Equipment)

As per the communication from the CGF on 2 May 2017, the CGF Sports Committee will shortly undertake a review of GFS10 rule with the respective Technical Delegates of International Federations and in conjunction with GOLDOC and interested CGAs

This exercise will focus specifically within the remit of competition kit, sport equipment and auxiliary field of play (FOP) apparel only. Please send any queries regarding GFS10 to the Andrew Hibbert, CGF Head of CGA Relations (<u>a.hibbert@thecgf.com</u>).

Team Kit - leisure wear, casual team kit

If CGAs are wishing to include the GC2018 emblem on any item of CGAs clothing, this requires approval from GOLDOC. Please send concepts drawings through to your CGA Relations Manager for approval **prior to** production.



NOTE: CGAs are reminded that Olympic rings must <u>not</u> appear on any items of clothing at a Commonwealth Games.



CGA visits to the Gold Coast

Is your CGA considering visiting the Gold Coast to view competition venues, training venues and the Commonwealth Games Village this year?

Please note that GOLDOC will not be able to facilitate CGA visits during September and October 2017. CGA visits will also be blocked out from December 4 to Games Time.



Sport FA Update

CGF Sport Updates

The CGF recently communicated several sport updates relating to GC2018. In particular:

Change of Women's Boxing Category – Welterweight (69kg)

As announced, the CGF has approved the replacement of the Women's +75kg weight category with the Women's 69kg Welterweight (64 – 69kg) weight category. Please click <u>here</u> for the updated Medal Event Program. (Note: this link expires in 30 days).

Additional Women's Medal Events

The CGF and GOLDOC confirmed the addition of 3 Women's Boxing events, a Women's Weightlifting event and the 3 Women's Track Cycling events in 2018. This is an exciting step forward in ensuring GC2018 is the first multi-sport games to achieve gender parity of medal events.

The CGF also agreed to assign a designated pool of CGA Primary Allocations to ensure depth of competition in the Women's Boxing and Women's Team Pursuit events, recognising the existing open-allocation caps.



Women's Boxing



The CGF have confirmed that where a CGA elects to enter more than three (3) athletes in Women's Boxing medal events (max 1 per event), they would be eligible to receive additional CGA Primary Allocations. CGAs must not exceed 13 athletes across all 16 Boxing events. This does not change.

However, the additional CGA Primary Allocations mean that a CGA would be eligible to enter more athletes in any open-allocation discipline.

For example:

- CGA has 20 Primary Allocations.
- CGA enters five (5) athletes in Women's boxing events.
- CGA may earn two additional Primary Allocations.
- Therefore, CGA would be eligible to enter 22 athletes across open-allocation sports. CGA must not enter more than 13 athletes in Boxing.

The timeline and acceptance process for confirming these allocations is being discussed with the CGF, and will be communicated with CGAs as soon as finalised.

Women's Track Cycling



Where a CGA enters the Women's Team Pursuit, they will be eligible to enter thirty-four (34) athletes across Cycling disciplines. This is an increase of one (1) to the existing CGA maximum of thirty-three (33) across Cycling.

If a CGA is ranked in the top six (6) on the UCI Ranking Database for Women's Team Pursuit at 22 September 2017, they will also earn one (1) additional CGA

Primary Allocation. As with the Boxing example, this is an increase to the CGA's Primary Allocation and the CGA is able to use this allocation in any open-allocation sport.

For all applicants, it is important to remember this isn't a first come, first served process. This is based on merit with all applicants to undertake a range of scenario questioning and one on one interviews.




Queen's Baton Relay FA Update OBR finishes its African adventure

Currently the QBR is in South Africa from 15 – 20 May, its final stop in Africa before making its way to the tropical island nations of the Caribbean.
