Lawn Bowls Match Statistics Team (2019-2022)

JOB DESCRIPTION

AIM/PURPOSE

Bowls Jersey (BJ) has secured a powerful computer programme that will help to evaluate and dissect a player's performance. The aim is to have a team of 6 (maximum) trained match statisticians.

This will help the CGAJ and BJ to develop a meaningful set of information over the next 3 years which will assist when selection decisions need to be made. This will be a particularly useful mechanism due to the inter-sport comparisons that the CGAJ have to make.

POSSIBLE WORK LOAD/ TIMETABLE

2019	March/April	• CGAJ / BJ to advertise the job
	May	• Meet potential team members and agree introductory/training programme for 2019.
	June / July	• Training and practice. CI Finals 1/2 June first target event.
	August / Sept	• Work at club and island events
	October	Team in place

Any bowlers who are interested in being on the Birmingham 2022 pathway have been set a deadline of Dec 2019 to sign up. All those on the pathway will be expected to use the statistics team on a regular basis to get "official" percentages for their log book. This will include indoor bowls 2019/20. (Players who join before the deadline can request support as and when the team is in place)

Mission: Create, and enhance a development structure whereby the majority of Jersey athletes place in the top 50% of their field

- 2020**
- All pathway registered bowlers may now request for a member of the team to mark a game. According to the number registered there may need to be a minimum/maximum number set per player.
 - The aim is to cover all major local events AND to travel to off island events.
 - The CGAJ will be applying to the CGF for funding to assist with the costs of travel. 2020 sees the World Champs in Australia (May/June) and it's imperative that at least 2 of the team attend this event. The CGAJ will make funds available for this kind of event.
 - The "team" will need to meet to plan what they can do and what they wish to do. It must be stated that this role may well detract from the post holder's personal bowls programme. The 2020-2021 indoor programme will be an integral part of the pathway.
- 2021**
- At present, there are no "world" events in 2021 **BUT** BJ are already planning at least one event over and above the "norm".
 - The programme should have bedded in and will evolve.
- 2022**
- The Birmingham games (July /August) will offer the chance for ALL the team to have some time at the games.
 - There are 2 weeks of competition to be shared.

Note

When we are attending competitions, we will be measuring performances of games not including performance pathway athletes. This will help build a broad/comprehensive picture of high performance bowls.

GENERAL PLANNING AND ADMINISTRATION

PP bowlers will be asked to plan on a month by month basis. They will liaise with the PP administrator highlighting matches where recording would be beneficial. Matches can then be allocated by the administrator across the team a month in advance.

PRIVACY / ANONYMITY / INTEGRITY / CONFIDENTIALITY

Recorders are expected to maintain 100% confidentiality. All results will be shared with the individual athlete only.

Any comparison/test matches will not be shared and players outside the PP will be anonymous.
